In China- A Christian woman from Shenzhen penned a letter titled, "Horrible," to describe the abuse her family suffered at the hands of governmental authorities. Shi Minglei was leaving for work on the morning of July 22nd when she saw a group of officials hiding in the fire escape. They rushed into her home, breaking down the door, to arrest her husband, Cheng Yuan. Cheng is reported to be a member of a non-government organization. Pray that Gods peace which surpasses all understanding will continue to rest on Cheng, Shi and their young daughter. Prayerfully uphold the many Christians in China who are imprisoned for their faith and that Gods peace will continue to rest on His people
