OUR CHURCH ANNOUNCEMENTS

Council Announcement re: Covid-19 Protocols

Council would like to clear up uncertainty concerning COVID protocols being followed at church. We are following AB Gov. "Guidelines for Mass Gatherings" for worship services and "Guidelines for Day Camps" for Sunday School and youth ministries. These guidelines can be found on the AB Gov. website. After prayerful consideration, these are the applicable protocols Council has implemented:

Mass Gathering Guidelines:

- Signs to "Do not enter if not feeling well" and "self-assess" are on each exterior door
- · Notice in weekly bulletin requesting social distancing and not to attend if feeling unwell
- Sanitary stations at each door, with hand sanitizer and masks available
- Social distancing in sanctuary with extra space in hall to view services
- Offering plates and Lord's Supper trays are not passed between attendees
- Coffee after the service is served individually with no sharing of supplies & utensils
- All occupied spaces are cleaned after each use

Youth Day Camp Guidelines:

- Children should stay home if sick or have COVID-19 symptoms
- Cohorts, which are our individual classes & groups, should not mix
- Teachers should wash or sanitize hands before or upon entering the classroom
- Children encouraged to sanitize hands upon entering the classroom
- Masks recommended for teachers and students but not mandatory
- Teachers keep attendance records
- Materials provided for each participant
- Regular weekly cleaning of classrooms to take place
- Classrooms unoccupied for at least 24 hours between uses

All those attending worship are asked to be mindful of social distancing. Anyone experiencing common symptoms of COVID-19 should not attend.
