~In Ethiopia

- The town of Alaba Kulito in southern Ethiopia was the scene of a horrific attack against Christians, at least 13 churches were burned -- some completely destroyed -- along with other church-owned property, there were no fatalities reported. The trouble flared after a false rumour was spread that one or more mosques in the area had been burned. The area is predominantly Muslim, with constant tension between Christians and Muslims. Please prayerfully uphold all members of the attacked churches so that those responsible will come to understand the gospel and that the Lord will oversee the fruitful ministry despite opposition.
