In Algeria- On August 6th, a church in Bouidjima was officially closed by the National Gendarmerie for failing to have a permit. A government mandate, requiring permits for all churches, was issued in 2006. Yet, even though applications have been properly submitted, the requested permits were not issued. One Algerian church leader refers to the officials' implementation of such authorization as only a pretext, further surmising that "their goal is to end the church in Algeria. Pray for the members of the congregation and other Algerian churches facing similar uncertainty and oppression that God will give them strength to continue reaching out with His love and wisdom.
