In Russia- Legislation governing religious communities in Russia is complex and often inconsistently applied. In one recent case, a church community was barred from using its place of worship, even though it has done so for two decades. One church in the city has been demolished and another banned from using its building. The door of the Verkhnebakansky church building was sealed in early July. The church's leadership has appealed the decision and intend to continue presenting this case to the courts, as far as necessary.
