In Uzbekistan - A small number of religious communities in Uzbekistan received their registration in late 2019. However, many others are encountering major obstacles in their attempts to obtain registration, which would allow them to function legally. While Christians are one of the religious communities affected, other groups are facing similar impediments -- including bribe demands, land use permits and outright rejection. However, they are making repeated demands, including a mandated list of all church members' names and their passports. Pray that God will work mightily in the hearts and midst of Uzbekistan governing leaders
