~In Indonesia

• A married couple has been convicted and sentenced for their part in the bombing of three churches in Surabaya. Six members of the same family targeted three churches in the port city of Surabaya during their early morning services. Two brothers, ages 16 and 18, rode motorcycles up to the first church to detonate their bombs. Five minutes later, their father exploded a car bomb on the grounds of the second church; and their mother blew herself up, along with her young daughter at a third church. At least 14 people died in the attacks. We pray for repentance and salvation for this family.
