**Lethbridge Pro-Life** On Thursday, November 7 at 7:00 p.m., Lethbridge Pro-Life will be showing the documentary Fatal Flaws at Trinity Reformed Church, 1100 – 40 Ave N Lethbridge. Assisted death is one of the most contentious issues of our time. Many people believe that once it is legal, it becomes settled law and that it is no longer controversial. In the film Fatal Flaws, the Euthanasia Prevention Coalition and DunnMedia uncover the consequences of assisted suicide laws in certain U.S. states such as Oregon, in the Netherlands, Belgium and in Canada. **In Sudan-** Eight church leaders are facing criminal charges over a law that puts all church properties under the control of the government. In the high court's decision on October 7th, it was decided that there were grounds for a criminal case and the trial was to proceed. This court ruling comes one month after the appointment of Sudan's new transitional government. Government ministers have demonstrated positive signs that freedom of religion may be allowed. Remember these church leaders in your prayers as they now must contend with these charges.
